SMOKE-FREE POLICY

Smoking is not permitted inside sports venues where boxing training or competition occurs.

ANTI-DOPING POLICY (DRUGS IN SPORT)

Boxing SA has adopted the Anti-Doping Policy of Boxing Australia, available through our website. Registered boxers at SA representative level are liable to be drug-tested by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA).

SPARRING SAFETY POLICY

Affiliated gyms/clubs must display the Sparring Safety policy (as below) in their gym entry & sparring area. We can provide a laminated poster version of it on request.

- Sparring is only permitted under the direct supervision of a boxing coach accredited by the National Coaching Accreditation Scheme.
- You must wear a mouth-guard, head-guard and groin protector and females must wear a breast protector.
- You must wear proper sparring gloves in good condition. Bag mitts are not acceptable for sparring.
- Any blood must be cleaned from gloves and body in a timely manner.
- Sparring carries a risk of infection, injury or even death. If you participate in sparring, you acknowledge and accept this risk.
- Hepatitis B is a serious illness easily transmitted through blood contact. It can be prevented by vaccination, and you are strongly advised to see your doctor about getting vaccinated.

HARASSMENT and MEMBER PROTECTION

We expect all affiliates to abide by equal opportunity principles, and to guard against harassment or discrimination by coaches or people undertaking training. Boxing SA will have trained Member Protection officials to investigate complaints relating to inappropriate behaviour by anyone connected with our sport. All registered coaches, athletes and officials sign a commitment to abide by our Code of Conduct, reproduced overleaf for your information.

COACH REGISTRATION & INSURANCE

A coach from your club cannot corner a boxer at a tournament unless that coach is accredited with the National Coaching Accreditation Scheme (NCAS), **and** is **currently** registered as a Boxing SA Coach. Registration as a coach with Boxing SA must be renewed annually. Coaches who are registered with Boxing SA receive Professional Indemnity Insurance cover through our insurer. (Collective total \$2m with \$1,000 excess for each and every claim)

A person not registered as a Boxing SA Coach may assist a registered coach in the corner provided they have completed a Level One Coaching Course (this counts as training experience for the L1 certification).

Clubs/Gyms registered with Boxing SA receive Public Liability insurance cover (collective total now increased to \$20m with an excess of \$1,000 on each any every claim).

ATHLETE ACCIDENT/INJURY INSURANCE

SA registered boxers have **insurance cover** for bodily injury suffered solely through competing, sparring, training or travelling to/from venues for these activities. It offers **partial** reimbursement for ambulance, private hospital accommodation, physiotherapy, chiropractic, dental and ancillary medical procedures. Up to 50% of the net expenses incurred can be reimbursed, and for physiotherapy up to 75%. The maximum amount payable per claim is \$1200, and there is a \$20 excess per claim. The policy also offers lump sums for permanent disability or death, to a maximum of \$50,000. **Limited cover is provided for loss of earnings.** Hospital theatre fees are not covered, nor are doctor's fees exceeding the Medicare schedule fee (not insurable under law).

CLUB/GYM AFFILIATION PERIOD

Club/Gym Affiliation expires on 31 December and must be renewed before your club can enter boxers in a tournament
